

Proposed State Immigration Bills

[AB 3](#) would create state-funded regional centers to train defense attorneys and public defender's offices on immigration law and the consequences of criminal convictions.

[SB 6](#) would create a state program to fund legal representation for those facing deportation.

[SB 54](#) the California Values Act, would prevent the use of state and local public resources to aid federal Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents in deportation actions. This bill would require public hospitals (schools & courthouses too) to make public policies that limit immigration enforcement on their premises.

[AB 21](#) would restrict post-secondary educational institutions' collaboration with ICE, restrict access to campuses and data, and would require these institutions to provide healthcare, housing and legal services for students facing immigration risks or who lose financial aid if DACA is repealed.
