The Self-Assessment Toolkit provides public health leaders with tools and guidelines that help identify the skills, organizational practices, and infrastructure needed to address health equity and provide insights into steps Local Health Departments (LHD) can take to ensure their organization can have an impact on this growing problem.

The toolkit can be an effective part of GARE implementation – helping to establish a baseline for equity efforts, providing information that can be used to focus and refine equity plans and acting as a long-term measurement tool to assess progress towards internal equity goals.

The Self-Assessment is intended to serve a LHD in the following ways:

- Serve as the baseline measure of capacity, skills, and areas for improvement to support health equity-focused activities;
- Inventory the presence of a set of research-based organizational and individual traits that support the ability to perform effective health equity-focused work;
- Provide information to guide strategic planning processes and/or the process of developing and implementing strategies that improve capacities;
- Serve as an ongoing tool to assess progress towards identified goals developed through the assessment process;
