Resegregation and the Changing Bay Area: Opportunities for Health Leadership

This month, BARHII's new Director of Policy and Planning, Miriam Chion, will lead a conversation based on Urban Habitat's [Regional Resegregation: Reflections on Race, Class, and Power in Bay Area Suburbs](#) report and will discuss opportunities for the health sector to lead solutions.

The San Francisco Bay Area has enjoyed an increasing diversity of people, cultures, and industries while experiencing a substantial economic growth. However, the polarization of this growth, compounded by natural disasters and inequities across neighborhoods, has triggered a cascade of displacement with unhealthy housing conditions from growing homelessness to overcrowding conditions, suburban resegregation, long commutes, and expensive rents. The health sector can lead the delivery of healthy housing for all.
