### **ENDING INVISIBILITY FOR PACIFIC ISLANDERS**

Alameda, San Francisco, and San Mateo Counties have been collaborating with the Pacific Islander Taskforce (PITF) to end invisibility of Pacific Islanders in Public Health data. The way we currently collect data makes Pacific Islanders invisible and, therefore, difficult to address inequities in health outcomes of the Pacific Islander population. This month, the PITF will provide a presentation on its work to improve health equity by increasing PI visibility in data to address Pacific Islander's key health priorities.
